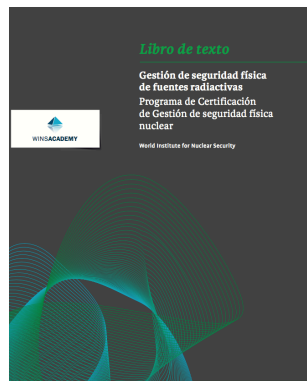
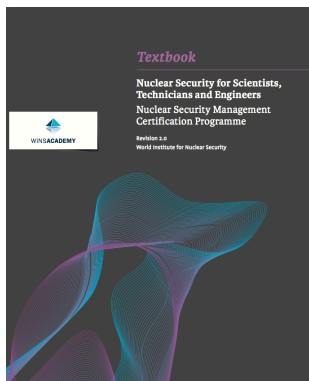
Highlights
